AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19302 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REDUCE REAL ESTATE LEVY FROM ONE PERCENT TO ONE-HALF PERCENT ON LAND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 19302 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 19302. Levy. There is hereby levied on all land property in Guam a yearly tax at the rate of one-half percent (1/2%) of the value thereof and one percent (1%) of the value of the improvements thereon. Such tax shall be assessed and collected in the manner prescribed in this Chapter. All proceeds derived by the government under any provision of this Chapter shall be deposited in the Treasury of Guam to the credit of the general fund."

Section 2. This Act and tax valuation of land and improvements as authorized by Public Law 11-74 shall become effective on the first Monday of March, 1974.
