



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR




AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 3000 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT
ENGLISH AND CHAMORRO ARE THE OFFICIAL
LANGUAGES OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 3000 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 3000. Official languages. English and
5 Chamorro are the official languages of Guam, provided,
6 however, that Chamorro language shall not be required for
7 official recording of public acts and transactions."
