






AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF  
EDUCATION AND THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM TO  
MAKE COMMITMENTS FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF  
INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL FROM OFF-ISLAND  
AND FOR THE ORDERING OF INSTRUCTIONAL  
SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Department of Education and the University  
3 of Guam are hereby authorized to make commitments for the  
4 recruitment of instructional personnel from off-island and  
5 for the ordering of instructional supplies and instructional  
6 equipment against their operational appropriations for fiscal  
7 year ending June 30, 1975:

1 Section 3. Appropriation Item VI, of Section 1 of Public  
2 Law 12-113 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "VI. For Library and Museum

- 4 1. Personnel Services \$ 583  
5 2. Off-island travel and  
6 transportation \$ 14,047  
7 3. Local travel, contractual  
8 services, supplies and  
9 materials, equipment and  
10 miscellaneous items, a  
11 reduction of \$ 5,745"

12 Section 4. Subsection A, of Section 5 of Public Law 12-60  
13 is hereby amended by adding the following positions:

14 "One (1) Director, Human Resources

15 Development, not to exceed per  
16 annum salary of \$ 14,560

17 One (1) Director, Residence

18 Instructor, not to exceed per  
19 annum salary of \$ 13,000

20 One (1) Program Coordinator, not

21 to exceed per annum salary of \$ 10,530"
