AN ACT MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM CONTRIBUTION TO MATCH FEDERAL GRANT CONTRIBUTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SINAJANA NEIGHBORHOOD FACILITIES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
4 sum of Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$48,000) to supplement the  
5 appropriation made by Section 21 of Public Law 12-60, Twelfth  
6 Guam Legislature, to match Federal funds for the construction  
7 of Sinajana neighborhood facilities.

8 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this  
9 Act shall be transferred to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal  
10 Authority and shall be made available for all expenses incident  
11 to the project for which made and shall remain in full force  
12 and effect until fully expended or the project is completed.

13 Section 3. Section 17 of Public Law 12-60 and Item U  
14 of Public Law 12-60 are hereby amended to read as follows:

15 "Section 17. The sum of Four Million Eight Hundred  
16 Forty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars  
17 (\$4,848,123) is hereby appropriated from any available  
18 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund  
19 to be allocated to the following educational facilities:

20 U. For school fencing, as authorized by  
21 Public Law 10-136 and installation of  
22 of electronic security systems, not to  
23 exceed a total of

1 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
2 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
3 sum of Fifty-Four Thousand Forty-Six Dollars (\$54,046) to be  
4 made effective July 1, 1974 for the following:

5 "1. For school fencing, as authorized by  
6 Public Law 12-136 and installation of  
7 electronic security systems, not to  
8 exceed a total of \$54,046"

9 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
10 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
11 of Six Thousand Forty-Six Dollars (\$6,046.00), for the operation  
12 of the South Pacific Games Commission for the fiscal year  
13 ending June 30, 1974, as follows:

14 "For off-island travel and transportation  
15 including per diem \$2,852.00  
16 For office supplies, equipment, materials,  
17 contractual services, and others \$3,194.00"

18 Section 6. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated the  
19 sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) for the  
20 purpose of constructing a multi-purpose senior citizens' com-  
21 munity center to serve the needs of the senior citizens of  
22 the municipality of Barrigada, said facility to be constructed  
23 on government-owned land which is located immediately west of the  
24 Barrigada public library and upon which was formerly located the  
25 Barrigada Elementary School.

26 Section 7. The funds authorized to be appropriated pursuant  
27 to Section 6 of this Act shall be used exclusively for the  
28 purpose of developing and constructing a multi-purpose facility,  
29 said facility to include adequate space to provide for recrea-  
30 tional rooms, meeting rooms, separate toilet and shower  
31 facilities and adequate parking space.
