AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11834 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THAT
REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS
OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM SHALL BE CON-
DUCTED IN PUBLIC.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11834 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 11834. Same: meetings. Meetings of the
5 Board of Regents shall be held at a regular time and
6 place each month. Notice of such meetings and of the
7 proposed agenda shall be published at least three days
8 prior to the holding of the meeting in a newspaper of
9 general circulation within the territory and such
10 meetings shall be open to the public. A portion of the
11 agenda of each regular meeting shall be set aside to
12 allow members of the public to address the Board.
13 Special meetings may be called by the chairman and, at
14 the discretion of a majority of the members, shall be
15 open or closed. It is the intent of this section to
16 encourage the Board to conduct as much of its business
17 as possible in open session before the public."
