



AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (i)  
TO SECTION 13140, GOVERNMENT CODE OF  
GUAM, RELATING TO RECORDING OR FILING  
FEES FOR MISCELLANEOUS DOCUMENTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (i) is hereby added to Section  
3 13140, Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "(i) For recording or filing any document required  
5 to be recorded by law for which a fee has not been  
6 provided, for each page or fraction thereof: Two Dollars  
7 (\$2.00)."
