AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 17350 AND 17351. AND TO REPEAL AND RECNACT SECTION 17352 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REDEFINE AUTOMOBILE PARKING SPACE REQUIREMENTS AND LOADING SPACE REGULATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 17350 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 17350. Automobile parking space. Offstreet automobile parking space shall be provided as follows:

- (a) For dwellings at least two (2) automobile parking spaces for each dwelling unit;
- (b) For hotels, at least one (1) automobile parking space for each four (4) guest rooms;
- (c) For places of assembly, such as churches, auditoriums or theaters with seating facilities, one (1) parking space for each four (4) seats;
- (d) For places of assembly, such as restaurants or night clubs without fixed seating facilities, one (1) parking space for each one hundred (100) square feet of customer area in such use;
- (e) For retail sales of building materials, and goods requiring extensive display areas, industrial buildings and warehouses, one (1) parking space for each eight hundred (800) square feet of area in such use, exclusive of loading requirements;
- (f) For retail and wholesale sales and services, exclusive of warehouse activity, at least one (1) space

for each one hundred and fifty (150) square feet or portion thereof of usable commercial floor area; 3 (g) For professional and business offices, public administration offices, one (1) parking space for each 4 5 two hundred and fifty (250) square feet or portion there-6 of of floor area; 7 (h) For offices and clinics, of healing arts, at 8 least five (5) spaces for each practitioner; 9 (i) For hospitals and nursing homes, at least one 10 (1) space for each two (2) beds; 11 (j) Three (3) spaces for every four (4) employees; 12 (k) Total parking requirements will be a total of 13 all applicable elements in paragraphs (a) through (k); 14 (1) Appropriate parking space for open space 15 activities such as swimming beaches, picnic areas, 16 campgrounds, boating areas, shall be determined by 17 the Territorial Planning Commission." Section 2. Section 17351 of the Government Code of Guam 18 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19 20 "Section 17351. General requirements. (a) Automobile 21 parking space required by this Title shall be provided 22 at the time of the erection of any main building or at 23 the time any existing main building is enlarged or 24 increased in capacity by adding dwelling units, guest 25 rooms or floor area, and such parking space shall there-26 after be maintained. 27 (b) In the case of a dwelling, the automobile 28 parking space shall be on the same lot and may be 29 provided either in a private garage or in a private 30 automobile parking area. 31 (c) In the case of multi-residential buildings, 32 churches, theaters, clinics, commercial or industrial - 2 -

buildings, the automobile parking space shall be on the same lot or may be provided in a parking garage available to the public or a private parking area adjacent thereto.

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(d) Every automobile parking space shall contain a minimum of one hundred and eighty (180) square feet and shall have adequate access to a public right of way."

Section 3. Section 17352 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

"Section 17352. Loading space. Off-street loading spaces for every commercial or industrial building shall be provided, located and scaled to meet the anticipated needs of all establishments and activities likely to require such space. In general, off-street loading space shall be located in service areas at the rear or sides of establishments in such a way that there will be minimum interference with off-street parking or vehicular movement in off-street parking areas."
