AN ACT REQUIRING THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY TO CONNECT ELECTRICAL POWER TO CERTAIN EXISTING SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 21503.1 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 21503.1. Power, duty to connect. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Government Code of Guam or any duly promulgated rule or regulation except those service rules and regulations of the Authority, the Authority shall not refuse to connect electrical power to any single family residence because said residence fails to meet specified public health or waste water standards."

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11018 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO NAME THE YIGO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL THE "FRANCISCO BAZA LEON GUERRERO SCHOOL".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11018 is hereby added to the Government

Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11018. Francisco Baza Leon Guerrero
Elementary School. The elementary school, currently
under construction, which is located in the municipality
of Yigo is hereby renamed the 'Francisco Baza Leon
Guerrero School' to honor the late Francisco Baza
Leon Guerrero from Chalan Pago, who was known and
venerated by all Guamanians as former Speaker of the
Legislature, and as the Father of the Organic Act. At
such ceremony as the Director deems appropriate, said
school shall be so officially named, at which time a
plaque bearing the name, picture and a brief history
of the contributions of Francisco Baza Leon Guerrero
to Guam shall be affixed at a suitable spot within the
school."
