1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:


2 Section 1. A new Section 21503.1 is hereby added to the  
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 21503.1. Power, duty to connect. Notwith-  
5 standing any other provision of the Government Code of  
6 Guam or any duly promulgated rule or regulation except  
7 those service rules and regulations of the Authority,  
8 the Authority shall not refuse to connect electrical  
9 power to any single family residence because said  
10 residence fails to meet specified public health or waste  
11 water standards."







AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11018 TO THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO NAME THE  
YIGO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL THE "FRANCISCO  
BAZA LEON GUERRERO SCHOOL".

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11018 is hereby added to the Government  
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 11018. Francisco Baza Leon Guerrero  
5 Elementary School. The elementary school, currently  
6 under construction, which is located in the municipality  
7 of Yigo is hereby renamed the 'Francisco Baza Leon  
8 Guerrero School' to honor the late Francisco Baza  
9 Leon Guerrero from Chalan Pago, who was known and  
10 venerated by all Guamanians as former Speaker of the  
11 Legislature, and as the Father of the Organic Act. At  
12 such ceremony as the Director deems appropriate, said  
13 school shall be so officially named, at which time a  
14 plaque bearing the name, picture and a brief history  
15 of the contributions of Francisco Baza Leon Guerrero  
16 to Guam shall be affixed at a suitable spot within the  
17 school."
