AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 23152 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO
SCHOOL BUS SAFETY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23152 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 23152. The Director of Public Works shall
5 insure that no public vehicle transporting students to
6 and from school shall be so loaded that more than one
7 student occupies a seat designed for one person or so
8 that any student is required to stand while the vehicle
9 is in motion. Any violation of this section shall be a
10 misdemeanor."
