AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE GUAM TEACHER CORPS PROJECT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A Subsection w is hereby added to Section 2

Part I.V.A. of Public Law 12-150 to read as follows:

"W. Teacher Corps Program.

1. The sum of Three Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$358,400); provided however, that no more than One Hundred Two Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$102,345) shall be expended for personal services for positions listed in Schedule 28(W) of Section 3, Part I of this Act."

Section 2. Schedule 28(W) is hereby added to Section 3, Part I of Public Law 12-150 as follows:

"Schedule 28(W) - Personal Services for University of

Guam - Teacher Corps Program

(Section 2, V.A.w.l)

- One (1) Project Director at pay range 34.
- One (1) Administrative Secretary at pay range 19.
- One (1) Program Development Specialist at pay range 20.
- Three (3) Teachers VI at pay range 28.

Twenty-Two (22) part-time positions."

Section 3. Schedule 28(P) of Section 3, Part I of Public
Law 12-150 is hereby amended by adding the following positions:
"One (1) Administrative Assistant at pay range 19.

Eleven (11) part-time positions."

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Section 4. Schedule 28(U) of Section 3, Part I of Public

Law 12-150 is hereby amended by adding the following positions:

"Schedule 28(U) - Personal Services for University of

Guam Land Grant Program

(Section 2,b. Expansion)

- One (1) Chief, Extension Service at pay range 35.
- One (1) Agricultural Extension Agent at pay range 30.
- One (1) Agricultural Extension Agent III at pay range 27.
- One (1) Assistant Director at pay range 34;

 provided however, that no more than thirty-two (32)

 employees shall be maintained at any one time at the Land

 Grant College."

Section 5. Schedule 14(D) of Section 3, Part I of Public
Law 12-150 is hereby amended by adding the following positions:

"One (1) Supply Expediter at pay range 9."

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds of the General Fund the sum of Three Thousand Seven.

Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars (\$3,752) to reimburse the Guam

Parents Teacher Association for the Deaf and Blind for the transportation of six deaf teenagers to Hyalite Youth Camp at Bozeman, Montana. The certifying officer of the Department of Education shall be certifying officer for this appropriation.

Section 7. Section 11814 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 11814. Students entitled to awards. There are hereby established twenty (20) professional and technical annual awards for undergraduate and graduate studies. Funds appropriated for the purpose of providing loans and professional and technical awards and which are not totally expended may be used in succeeding years

so as to increase the number of annual awards; provided, 1 however, that in awarding additional awards or loans, 2 first preference shall be given to those applicants who 3 have been accepted or who have been admitted to graduate 4 programs leading to a degree in medicine, dentistry or 5 law. Applicants who have not complied with the deadlines 6 established by the Board for the FY 1974-1975 shall have 7 until September 1, 1974 to file applications. The awards 9 provided in this subchapter are subject to the following 10 limitations: (a) The applicant must be a bona fide resident of 11 Guam and a United States citizen. 12 (b) The applicant must agree that after completion or 13 termination of his course of studies for which the award 14 was granted, he will return to work on Guam for a period 15 of one (1) year. 16 (c) The applicant must present to the Board prior to 17 the granting of the award satisfactory proof that he has 18 been admitted to the college or university as a full-time 19 student to pursue a program of study in the area of the 20 21 award applied for. (d) The colleges or universities must be properly 22 accredited and must be approved by the Board. 23 (e) The Board shall select the recipients of the awards 24 upon the basis of scholastic ability, financial need, 25 aptitude, and health, as well as the likelihood of the 26 recipient returning to Guam to fill its professional needs. 27 (f) No award shall be made under this subchapter unless 28 the Board has made a written finding that the proposed 29 award shall be for professional or technical skills needed 30 31 in the territory of Guam." - 3 -

Section 8. Section 22 is hereby added to Part Twelve of Public Law 12-150 to read as follows:

"In determing eligibility for trainees under the Guam Teacher Corps Program, first priority shall be given to those persons who are limited-term teachers."

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
