AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
PURPOSE OF FUNDING THE GUAM TEACHER CORPS
PROJECT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A Subsection w is hereby added to Section 2

3 Part I.V.A. of Public Law 12-150 to read as follows:

"w. Teacher Corps Program.

1. The sum of Three Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Four
Hundred Dollars (\$358,400); provided however, that no more
than One Hundred Two Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Five
Dollars (\$102,345) shall be expended for personal services
for positions listed in Schedule 28(W) of Section 3, Part I
of this Act."

11 Section 2. Schedule 28(W) is hereby added to Section 3, Part
12 I of Public Law 12-150 as follows:

"Schedule 28(W) - Personal Services for University of
Guam - Teacher Corps Program
(Section 2,V.A.w.1)

One (1) Project Director at pay range 34.

One (1) Administrative Secretary at pay range 19.

One (1) Program Development Specialist at pay range 30.

Three (3) Teachers VI at pay range 28.

Twenty-Two (22) part-time positions."

21 Section 3. Schedule 28(P) of Section 3, Part I of Public
22 Law 12-150 is hereby amended by adding the following positions:

"One (1) Administrative Assistant at pay range 19.

Eleven (11) part-time positions."

2 however, that in awarding additional awards or loans,
3 first preference shall be given to those applicants who
4 have been accepted or who have been admitted to graduate
5 programs leading to a degree in medicine, dentistry or
6 law. Applicants who have not complied with the deadlines
7 established by the Board for the FY 1974-1975 shall have
8 until September 1, 1974 to file applications. The awards
9 provided in this subchapter are subject to the following
10 limitations:

11 (a) The applicant must be a bona fide resident of
12 Guam and a United States citizen.

13 (b) The applicant must agree that after completion or
14 termination of his course of studies for which the award
15 was granted, he will return to work on Guam for a period
16 of one (1) year.

17 (c) The applicant must present to the Board prior to
18 the granting of the award satisfactory proof that he has
19 been admitted to the college or university as a full-time
20 student to pursue a program of study in the area of the
21 award applied for.

22 (d) The colleges or universities must be properly
23 accredited and must be approved by the Board.

24 (e) The Board shall select the recipients of the awards
25 upon the basis of scholastic ability, financial need,
26 aptitude, and health, as well as the likelihood of the
27 recipient returning to Guam to fill its professional needs.

28 (f) No award shall be made under this subchapter unless
29 the Board has made a written finding that the proposed
30 award shall be for professional or technical skills needed
31 in the territory of Guam."

to those persons who are limited-term teachers."
