



Introduced by F. G. Lujan

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 12311.1 TO THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO  
RECOVERY OF FISH AND GAME, AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby added a new Section 12311.1 to  
3 Article I, Chapter IV, Title XIII of the Government Code of Guam  
4 to read as follows:

5 "Section 12311.1. Recovery of fish and game. It  
6 shall be unlawful for any person to kill, maim or injure  
7 any fish or game without making a reasonable effort to  
8 retrieve the fish or game and to include it in his or her  
9 daily bag or creel limit."

10 Section 2. Section 17350 of the Government Code of Guam  
11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 17350. Automobile parking space. Off-street  
13 automobile parking space shall be provided as follows:

14 (a) For dwellings, at least one (1) automobile  
15 parking space for each dwelling unit;

16 (b) For hotels, at least one (1) automobile  
17 parking space for each four (4) guest rooms;

18 (c) For places of assembly, such as churches,  
19 auditorium or theaters with seating facilities,  
20 one (1) parking space for each four (4) seats;

21 (d) For places of assembly, such as restaurants  
22 or night clubs without fixed seating facilities,  
23 one (1) parking space for each one hundred (100)  
24 square feet of customer area in such use;

1 (e) For retail sales of building materials,  
2 and goods requiring extensive display areas,  
3 industrial buildings and warehouses, one (1) parking  
4 space for each eight hundred (800) square feet of  
5 area in such use, exclusive of loading requirements;

6 (f) For retail and wholesale sales and  
7 services, exclusive of warehouse activity, at  
8 least one (1) space for each one hundred (100)  
9 square feet or portion thereof of unsable commercial  
10 floor area;

11 (g) For professional and business offices,  
12 public administration offices, one (1) parking  
13 space for each one hundred and fifty (150) square  
14 feet or portion thereof of floor area;

15 (h) For offices and clinics, of healing arts,  
16 at least five (5) spaces for each practitioner;

17 (i) For hospitals and nursing homes, at  
18 least one (1) space for each two (2) beds;

19 (j) Three (3) spaces for every four (4)  
20 employees;

21 (k) Total parking requirements will be a  
22 total of all applicable elements in paragraphs (a)  
23 through (k);

24 (l) Appropriate parking space for open space  
25 activities such as swimming, beaches, picnic areas,  
26 campgrounds, boating areas, shall be determined by  
27 the Territorial Planning Commission."
