AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11839.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM TO ENTER INTO A RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES OF THE STATE OF HAWAII, WHEREBY QUALIFIED STUDENTS OF BOTH JURISDICTIONS MAY BE ALLOWED TO ENROLL WITH A GUARANTEE OF WAIVER OF NON-RESIDENT TUITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 11839.1 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11839.1. The Board of Regents of the University of Guam is hereby authorized to enter into a reciprocal agreement with the University of Hawaii and with the community colleges of the State of Hawaii, whereby qualified students of both jurisdictions may be allowed to enroll with a guarantee of a waiver of nonresident tuition, provided, however, that the Board of Regents is hereby authorized to promulgate reasonable rules and regulations regarding implementation of this section."
