

Introduced by F. G. Lujan

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11880 OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO  
IN-SERVICE TRAINING FOR DEPARTMENT  
OF EDUCATION EMPLOYEES, AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11880 of the Government Code of Guam  
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 11880. In-service training for Department  
5 of Education employees. Any non-contract employee of the  
6 Department of Education in a permanent position who is a  
7 bona fide resident of the territory of Guam, who lacks  
8 not more than two (2) years or their equivalent in  
9 requirements for a baccalaureate degree in education,  
10 shall be entitled to enrollment at the University of Guam  
11 for the purpose of completing work toward such degree as  
12 an in-service training program, whereby he continues to  
13 receive his regular salary from the department, including  
14 all scheduled pay increases, so long as he maintains a  
15 normal work load and passing work at the college and so  
16 long as a program leading to the issuance of a baccalaureate  
17 degree in education is pursued; provided, however, that no  
18 person shall participate in such in-service program in  
19 excess of two (2) years or their equivalent. In addition,  
20 every person who participates in such program shall be  
21 obligated to work for the government of Guam for a period  
22 of two (2) years for each year of training received,  
23 failing which he shall be liable to repay the cost to the  
24 government of his training."

1           Section 2. Section 11826.5 of the Government Code of Guam  
2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3           "Section 11826.5. Commission status. The Territorial  
4 Commission on Education created pursuant to this Act shall  
5 take effect immediately upon passage of this Act and shall  
6 be the successor agency to the Territorial Commission on  
7 Education created by Executive Order 73-8. The Commission  
8 created by this Act shall be abolished when its work has  
9 been completed, but shall cease to exist no later than  
10 December 31, 1975."
