Bill No. 839

Introduced by F. R. Santos

AN ACT DIRECTING THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO  
TAKE NECESSARY STEPS TO OBTAIN SUITABLE  
LANDS FOR NEW CEMETERIES IN AGAT AND THE  
NORTHERN AREA, AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIA-  
TION THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1           WHEREAS, only a small amount of land in the Agat cemetery  
2 remains available for use by the citizens of that area; and

3           WHEREAS, the only other cemetery facilities which could  
4 be used by Agat residents are located several miles from the  
5 area, and the use thereof would cause undue hardship and  
6 inconvenience to said residents; and

7           WHEREAS, the residents of the northern area of Guam are in  
8 dire need of cemetery facilities as the only public cemetery is  
9 located in the southern area; now therefore

10           BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11           Section 1. The Governor of Guam is hereby directed to  
12 take the necessary steps to convert government-owned land in the  
13 Agat area and the northern area of Guam into new cemeteries, or,  
14 if no suitable government-owned land is available, to take the  
15 necessary steps to acquire privately-owned land for such  
16 purposes, through purchase, exchange of government land, or any  
17 other viable means. The Governor shall inform the Legislature  
18 within ninety (90) days of the enactment of this measure as to  
19 the sites to be set aside for approval by the Legislature, by  
20 resolution.

21           Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated  
22 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
23 General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the  
24 implementation of this Act.

1           Section 3. Subsection (g) of Section 17350 of the Govern-  
2           ment Code of Guam is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as  
3           follows:

4                     "(g) For professional and business offices, public  
5           administration offices, one (1) parking space for each  
6           four hundred (400) square feet or portion thereof of  
7           floor area."

8           Section 4. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated  
9           from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
10          General Fund the sum of Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$850.00)  
11          for a lowering device to used at Taguac Cemetery.
