AN ACT DIRECTING THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO TAKE NECESSARY STEPS TO OBTAIN SUITABLE LANDS FOR NEW CEMETERIES IN AGAT AND THE NORTHERN AREA, AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, only a small amount of land in the Agat cemetery remains available for use by the citizens of that area; and

WHEREAS, the only other cemetery facilities which could be used by Agat residents are located several miles from the area, and the use thereof would cause undue hardship and inconvenience to said residents; and

'WHEREAS, the residents of the northern area of Guam are in dire need of cemetery facilities as the only public cemetery is located in the southern area; now therefore

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The Governor of Guam is hereby directed to take the necessary steps to convert government-owned land in the Agat area and the northern area of Guam into new cemeteries, or, if no suitable government-owned land is available, to take the necessary steps to acquire privately-owned land for such purposes, through purchase, exchange of government land, or any other viable means. The Governor shall inform the Legislature within ninety (90) days of the enactment of this measure as to the sites to be set aside for approval by the Legislature, by resolution.

Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the implementation of this Act.

Section 3. Subsection (g) of Section 17350 of the Govern-1 ment Code of Guam is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as 2 3 follows: "(g) For professional and business offices, public administration offices, one (1) parking space for each 5 four hundred (400) square feet or portion thereof of 6 floor area." Section 4. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated 8 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$850.00) 10

for a lowering device to used at Taguac Cemetery.
