

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE
DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED VEHICLES AND
FOR PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE
SAME PURPOSE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 balance of the Abandoned Vehicle Fund the sum of Twenty Two
4 Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$22,700) for the removal and
5 disposal of abandoned vehicles found upon public and private
6 properties on Guam as follows:

- 7 1. For overtime compensation of Department of
8 Public Works personnel used in the removal
9 of abandon vehicles, not to exceed \$ 14,700
10 2. For equipment maintenance, to include motor
11 fuel, not to exceed \$ 8,000

12 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
13 balance of the Abandoned Vehicle Fund the sum of One Hundred
14 Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000) for the purchase of dump
15 trucks to aid in the removal and disposal of abandoned vehicles.

16 Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to
17 the contrary, the Director of the Department of Public Works
18 or his authorized designee or designees in writing are hereby
19 authorized to obligate or make commitments regarding the funds
20 appropriated by Sections 1 and 2 of this Act.

21 Section 4. The total of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
22 (\$150,000) from the appropriation made by Section 1 and appor-
23 tioned by Section 2. B.3 of Public Law 11-157 is hereby

1 reappropriated for the operations of the Office of the Special
2 Prosecutor for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975.

3 Section 5. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the
4 contrary, the Chief Judge, Superior Court of Guam or his
5 authorized designee or designees in writing are hereby
6 authorized to obligate or make commitments regarding the
7 funds appropriated by Section 4 of this Act. This authority
8 however shall expire upon the appointment of the Special
9 Prosecutor by the Chief Judge of the Superior Court of Guam, at
10 which time the Special Prosecutor or his authorized designee or
11 designees shall then assume the designated authority to obligate
12 or make commitments regarding the appropriations made by Section
13 4 of this Act.
