

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE  
LAND SURVEY FUND TO IMPLEMENT SECTION  
13970 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. PART FOUR - LAND SURVEY FUND of Public Law  
3 12-150 is hereby repealed and a new PART FOUR is added in lieu  
4 thereof as follows:

5 "PART FOUR - LAND SURVEY FUND

6 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappro-  
7 priated Surplus of the Land Survey Fund the sum of Three  
8 Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$320,000) to implement the  
9 provisions of Subsection (1) of Section 13970 of the Government  
10 Code of Guam.

11 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 shall be  
12 available for in-house expenses and contractual services  
13 incident to and including the following:

14 (1) The contracting of professional control survey  
15 experts on a limited term basis to formulate and standar-  
16 dize procedures and to familiarize and train local govern-  
17 ment personnel with advance control survey methods.

18 (2) Providing for the necessary surveying instruments  
19 and equipment needed for the densification of the Horizontal  
20 and Vertical Control of the Guam Geodetic Triangulation  
21 Net System.

22 (3) Providing for the tabulation and publication of  
23 all derived data in a systematic form.

1           (4) Providing for appropriate permanent monumentation  
2 and other incidental supplies.

3           (5) Contract local professional surveying firms to  
4 implement the provisions of Section 13810 of the Government  
5 Code of Guam.

6           (6) Contract properly qualified local surveyors for  
7 the replacement of destroyed monuments and placement of  
8 new monuments, reference markers, and other survey  
9 functions, incidental to completing both the Horizontal  
10 position and Vertical elevation of the Guam Geodetic  
11 Triangulation net and densification.

12           Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappro-  
13 priated Surplus of the Land Survey Fund the sum of One Hundred  
14 Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000) to implement the provisions of  
15 Subsections (2) and (3) of Section 13970 of the Government Code  
16 of Guam.

17           Section 4. The appropriation made by Section 3 shall be  
18 made available for in-house expenses and contractual services  
19 incident to and including the following:

20           (1) The contracting of properly qualified consultants  
21 to research, inventory, and tabulate by punch card or  
22 other appropriate system, all documents and maps recorded  
23 or on file at the Department of Land Management or else-  
24 where that affect title to real property to determine  
25 the full extent of unregistered government land.

26           (2) Providing for the examination, selection, and  
27 verification of existing boundaries required to complete  
28 such surveys as already exist for registration proceedings.

29           Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappro-  
30 priated Surplus of the Land Survey Fund the sum of Seventy  
31 Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) to implement the provisions of  
32 Subsection (4) of Section 13970 of the Government Code of Guam.

1 Section 6. The appropriation made by Section 5 shall be  
2 made available for in-house expenses and contractual services  
3 incident to and including the following:

4 (1) Providing for the final field surveys, monumenta-  
5 tion, calculations, and drafting of Land Registration maps;

6 (2) Providing for the title examination and preparation  
7 of title abstracts on each surveyed and mapped parcel; and

8 (3) Providing for Public Notices and other legal costs  
9 needed by the Attorney General relevant to Land Registration  
10 proceedings, provided that said costs do not exceed a  
11 maximum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) from the total  
12 amount under Section 5 of this Act.

13 Section 7. The appropriations made by all the above  
14 sections shall become effective July 1, 1974."

15 Section 2. Item B of Schedule Forty-Two of Section 3 of  
16 Public Law 12-150 is hereby amended as follows:

17 "A. Survey Division

18 One (1) Chief of Cadastre at pay range 35

19 One (1) Surveyor at pay range 32

20 One (1) Surveyor at pay range 29

21 Two (2) Surveyors at pay range 26

22 Four (4) Surveyors at pay range 20

23 One (1) Administrative Assistant at pay range 19

24 Three (3) Survey Technicians at pay range 18

25 One (1) Survey Technician at pay range 15

26 One (1) Clerk at pay range 15

27 One (1) Clerk Typist at pay range 13

28 Three (3) Survey Aides at pay range 12

29 One (1) Clerk at pay range 9

30 Two (2) Survey Aides at pay range 6"
