

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 4111.1 TO
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE
TO COMPENSATION AND ANNUAL LEAVE FOR
FIREMEN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 4111.1 is hereby added to the
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 4111.1. Firemen: compensation: annual and
5 sick leave. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, rule,
6 regulation, or order to the contrary, all firemen within
7 the Department of Public Safety, except fire inspectors
8 and the deputy chief, shall be compensated at the regular
9 hourly rate of pay being paid them on September 1, 1974
10 for up to ninety (90) hours worked during any pay period,
11 and shall be compensated at one and one-half times said
12 regular hourly rate for hours worked in excess of one
13 hundred twenty (120) hours per pay period. The Civil
14 Service Commission shall adjust the pay schedule for
15 firemen to that schedule which pays, based on a standard
16 pay period of ninety (90) hours, the hourly amount nearest
17 to the hourly amount being paid firemen on September 1,
18 1974.

19 (b) All hours of work performed by firemen during a
20 legal holiday shall be compensated at double the regular
21 hourly rate, irrespective of work shifts, provided,
22 however, that work performed on such a holiday in excess

1 of nine (9) hours shall be compensated at the regular
2 hourly rate.

3 (c) Firemen shall be charged no more than nine (9)
4 hours annual leave or sick leave for any given day on
5 which such leave is taken.

6 (d) All other laws, rules, regulations applicable to
7 firemen not inconsistent with this section shall remain
8 in full force and effect.

9 (e) This section shall not be construed to limit
10 the authority of the Civil Service Commission to adjust
11 the rate of compensation for firemen so long as the
12 regular hourly rate of compensation is not adjusted to
14 an amount less than that in effect on September 1, 1974."
15 Section 2. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

16 Section 3. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
17 from any available balance of the Unappropriated Surplus of
18 the General Fund such sums as are necessary to implement this
19 Act.
