


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CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER  
OF \$1,040,000 FROM THE TERRITORIAL  
HIGHWAY FUND TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY  
AGENCY OF GUAM FUND, AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Director, Department of Administration, is

3 hereby authorized to transfer to the Public Utility Agency Fund

4 from any available cash in the Territorial Highway Fund, such

5 funds not to exceed the sum of One Million Forty Thousand

6 Dollars (\$1,040,000) as he deems necessary to pay salaries of

7 the employees of the Public Utility Agency of Guam and to

8 satisfy other unpaid obligations of that agency. Notwithstanding

9 any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Director,

10 Department of Administration, shall be the Certifying Officer

11 of any expenditures of the funds herein authorized to be

12 transferred and shall make certification thereof only when he

13 is satisfied that the Public Utility Agency Fund has insuffi-

14 cient cash to pay the employees of that agency or satisfy other

15 unpaid obligations thereof. The sums transferred under this

16 section shall be in the form of an interest-free loan to the

17 Public Utility Agency of Guam for a period not to exceed six

18 (6) months, provided, however, that such loan shall be forgiven

19 upon the appropriation by the Legislature to the Territorial

20 Highway Fund of funds sufficient to reimburse that fund for any

21 transfers made therefrom under this section. The Chief Officer

22 of the Public Utility Agency of Guam shall file with the Guam

23 Legislature a report no later than the 15th day of each and

1 every month delineating and providing an explanation for the  
2 transfers made and the expenditures thereunder charged and it  
3 shall be the duty of the Director, Department of Administration,  
4 to assist the Chief Officer of the Public Utility Agency of  
5 Guam and to co-author said monthly report.

6 Section 2. Commencing on the effective date of this Act  
7 no funds within the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund shall be  
8 used to pay for employment of a Public Relations Consultant or  
9 to pay the salary of any person who is not on the payroll of the  
10 Public Utility Agency of Guam on December 20, 1974. The Certify-  
11 ing Officer of the Public Utility Agency of Guam shall be  
12 personally liable for any expenditure made in violation of this  
13 section.

14 Section 3. Notwithstanding any provision in Section 90 of  
15 the Code of Civil Procedure to the contrary, the Governor may  
16 appoint as a judge any person who has previously held that  
17 office in Guam.
