

AN ACT MAKING A TRANSFER AND APPROPRIATION
TO THE GUAM TELEPHONE AUTHORITY FOR CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) to be transferred to
5 the Guam Telephone Authority for improvements, extensions, and
6 expansion of telephone facilities.

7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
8 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
9 sum of Nine Hundred Fourteen Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Five
10 Dollars (\$914,165) to the Social Security Insurance Program,
11 pursuant to Section 4204 (C & E), Government Code of Guam, as
12 amended by Public Law 11-135, and Section 210(a) (7) (e) of the
13 Social Security Act, for the period beginning January 1, 1973
14 to June 30, 1974.

15 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
16 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
17 sum of Seven Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand Four Hundred
18 Dollars (\$773,400) to include Grants pursuant to the Hill-Burton
19 Act (Title VI of the Public Health Service Act) of \$696,000 to
20 supplement Section 9 of Public Law 12-114 for the construction
21 of the Northern Area Health Center.

22 Section 4. The sum of Two Million Nine Hundred Ninety-One
23 Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars (\$2,991,565) is hereby
24 transferred from the Hospital Construction Fund, created by

1 Section 37, Part One of Public Law 12-60, to the General Fund
2 to satisfy the appropriations made by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of
3 this Act.

4 Section 5. Effective July 1, 1975, the sum of Two Million
5 Nine Hundred Ninety-One Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Five Dollars
6 (\$2,991,565) shall be transferred from any available funds in
7 the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Hospital
8 Construction Fund, created by Section 37, Part One of Public
9 Law 12-60.

10 Section 6. Section 17 and Item U thereunder of Public Law
11 12-60 are hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 17. The sum of Four Million Seven Hundred
13 Forty-Eight Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars
14 (\$4,478,123) is hereby appropriated from any available
15 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
16 to be allocated to the following educational facilities:

17 U. For school fencing, as authorized
18 by Public Law 10-136 and installation
19 of electronic security systems, not
20 to exceed a total of \$95,954"

21 Section 7. Subsections III.D.1, 2 and 4 of Section 2,
22 Part One of Public Law 12-150 are hereby amended to read as
23 follows:

24 "III. PUBLIC HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES

25 D. GUAM ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

26 1. For Personal Services, not to
27 exceed Three Hundred Seventy-
28 One Thousand Fifty-Five Dollars
29 (\$371,055) for the positions
30 enumerated in Schedule Twenty-Five
31 of Section 3 of this Act.

1	2. For Personnel Benefits, not to	
2	exceed the total of Forty	
3	Thousand Twenty-Six Dollars	
4	(\$40,026) as follows:	
5	For contribution to the Retire-	
6	ment Fund, not to exceed	\$ 35,512
7	For health and hospital	
8	insurance, not to exceed	\$ 3,848
9	For life insurance, not to	
10	exceed	\$ 666
11	4. For Contractual Services, not	
12	to exceed the total of One	
13	Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand	
14	Eight Hundred Twenty-Five	
15	Dollars (\$149,825) as follows:	
16	For telephone, water, sewer,	
17	power and janitorial services,	
18	not to exceed	\$ 15,000
19	For rental of office space,	
20	not to exceed	\$ 19,100
21	For rental of copying machine,	
22	not to exceed	\$ 2,700
23	For rental of boats, diving	
24	gear, aircraft for aerial	
25	mapping, not to exceed	\$ 525
26	For advertisement, not to	
27	exceed	\$ 1,500
28	For rental of postage meter	
29	and postage, not to exceed	\$ 700
30	For board members' fees, not	
31	to exceed	\$ 2,000

1	For legal services, not	
2	to exceed	\$ 5,000
3	For vehicle maintenance,	
4	not to exceed	\$ 6,000
5	For cablegrams and long	
6	distance telephone calls,	
7	not to exceed	\$ 400
8	For publications of reports,	
9	rules, regulations, training	
10	manuals and maps, not to	
11	exceed	\$ 2,600
12	For instrument repair and	
13	maintenance, not to exceed	\$ 1,300
14	For films processing, printing	
15	and production of environmen-	
16	tal programs for television,	
17	not to exceed	\$ 1,000
18	For installation of laboratory	
19	and field equipment, not	
20	to exceed	\$ 8,000
21	For special study by the U.S.	
22	Geological Survey on ground	
23	and surface water, not to	
24	exceed	\$ 33,000
25	For technical assistance to	
26	perform wastewater facilities	
27	construction, grant planning	
28	and management activities,	
29	not to exceed	\$ 15,000
30	For renovation of office space,	
31	not to exceed	\$ 36,000"

1 Section 8. A new Section 27 to Part Twelve of Public Law
2 12-150 is hereby added to read as follows:

3 "Section 27. All appropriations made by this Act,
4 and any amendments thereto, for the 'Government of Guam
5 Retirement Fund' shall also be construed as appropriations
6 for contribution to the Social Security Retirement
7 Insurance Program Fund."

8 Section 9. Subsection 8 of Section 4.I of Part One of Public
9 Law 12-150 is hereby amended to read as follows:

10 "8. The appropriations made pursuant to Subsections
11 4.I., 1 through 7, shall include Eighty-Four Thousand
12 One Hundred Fifty-Four Dollars (\$84,154) of Federal
13 Grants-in-Aid. Additionally, the amount of Twenty-One
14 Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$21,728)
15 appropriated pursuant to Subsections 4.I., 1 through 7,
16 from the General Fund is hereby specifically identified
17 as local matching to the Federal Grants-in-Aid (LEAA
18 Funds)."

19 Section 10. Notwithstanding any other provisions of laws,
20 rules or regulations to the contrary, the Speaker of the Guam
21 Legislature is hereby authorized to reapportion or reallocate
22 any and all appropriations made for the operations of the
23 Twelfth Guam Legislature for the period beginning January 1,
24 1974 and ending January 12, 1975.

25 Section 11. Subsection (h) of Section 21603 of the
26 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

27 "(h) Enter into contracts with government of the
28 territory, with the United States or with a reputable
29 institution for loans or grants;"

30 Section 12, Section 21735 of the Government Code of Guam
31 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 "Section 21735. Short term and long term borrowing.
2 The Board may at any time or from time to time, by
3 ordinance adopted by a majority of all members of the
4 Board and approval by the Governor, incur indebtedness
5 for any lawful purpose for any period not to exceed five
6 (5) years for short term loan and fifteen (15) years for
7 long term loan evidenced by contract with any person or
8 by one or more promissory notes. Any such indebtedness
9 shall be incurred subject and subordinate to any con-
10 tractual obligation of the Board to the holders of any
11 bonds and the principal thereof and interest thereon may
12 be repaid (a) from revenues, or (b) if incurred for a
13 purpose for which bonds may be issued, from revenues or
14 from the proceeds of sale of bonds."

15 Section 13. Section 7001 of the Government Code of Guam
16 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 "Section 7001. The Department of Law shall have
18 cognizance of all legal matters in which the government
19 of Guam is in anywise interested. Except as otherwise
20 provided by this Section, the Attorney General shall not
21 delegate to any attorney in private practice in Guam the
22 collection of any account or other obligation owing to the
23 government of Guam or to any agency or instrumentality
24 thereof. The Attorney General may contract with private
25 attorneys within the territory of Guam for the prompt
26 collection of debts owed public corporations including
27 but not limited to the Guam Power Authority, Guam Transit
28 Authority, and the Guam Telephone Authority. For purposes
29 of this Section, any attorney who contracts with the
30 Attorney General shall be deemed to be an Assistant
31 Attorney General. It shall have cognizance of all matters

1 pertaining to public prosecution."

2 Section 14. Schedule Three of Section 3 of Public Law
3 12-150 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Schedule Three - Personal Services for Department of
5 Law (Section 2.I.C.1).

6 One (1) Attorney General at \$19,000 per annum.

7 One (1) Special Assistant to the Attorney General at
8 \$26,000 per annum.

9 One (1) Private Secretary at \$8,500 per annum.

10 One (1) Criminal Justice Librarian at \$5,940 per annum.

11 Two (2) Deputy Attorney Generals at pay range 38.

12 Twelve (12) Attorneys at pay range 36.

13 One (1) Administrative Assistant to Attorney General
14 at pay range 28.

15 Two (2) Special Investigators at pay range 26.

16 Five (5) Administrative Secretaries at pay range 19.

17 Two (2) Law Clerks at pay range 16.

18 One (1) Clerk Typist at pay range 13.

19 One (1) Clerk at pay range 6."

20 Section 15. There is hereby appropriated from any available
21 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
22 sum of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) to the Codes of Guam
23 Printing Fund for printing of the 1973 Code supplements.

24 Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any available
25 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
26 of Two Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$228,000), said
27 sum to be apportioned as follows:

28 (a) Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars
29 (\$225,000) to be transferred to the Legislature
30 Operations Fund for the operations of the Twelfth Guam
31 Legislature for the period ending January 12, 1975 or when

1 the Twelfth Guam Legislature adjourns sine die, said
2 sum to be apportioned, or allocated, further by the
3 Speaker of the Twelfth Guam Legislature; and

4 (b) Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) to be transferred
5 to the Speaker's Contingency Fund within the Legislature
6 Operations Fund.
