AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 25305.1 TO
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO CREATE
A STUDENT ECOLOGY PROGRAM AND TO AUTHO-
RIZE AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND SAME.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 26305.1 is hereby added to
3 Chapter IV, Title XXVII of the Government Code of Guam to read
4 as follows:

5 "Section 26305.1. Student Ecology Program. (a) Not-
6 withstanding Section 26305, the Council may employ up to
7 six hundred (600) students in grades nine (9) through
8 twelve (12) for a ten (10) week summer period at the
9 minimum wage rate in order to further implement the
10 purposes and goals of this Act. In addition, a cadre of
11 up to sixty (60) students from the University of Guam
12 may be employed to supervise and assist these high school
13 students in the day to day activities of the Corps and
14 shall be compensated at a rate equal to fifty (50) cents
15 more per hour than the minimum wage rate.

16 (b) The Council, in implementing the program set
17 forth in Subsection (a), shall insure that:

18 (1) the students and the supervisors are
19 provided hot lunches each day while they are employed.

20 (2) the students and the supervisors are
21 provided transportation to and from the work area
22 and are compensated for travel time."

23 Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated

1 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
2 General Fund the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars
3 (\$300,000.00) for the purpose of implementing the provisions
4 of Section 1.
