

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 13808.2 TO  
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT  
THE ORIGINAL TRACING OF A MAP BE THE  
PERSONAL PROPERTY OF AN OWNER.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13808.2 is hereby added to the Govern-  
3 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 13808.2. Original tracing. Notwith-  
5 standing any provision of law, rule or regulation  
6 to the contrary, the original tracing of a map, plat,  
7 sketch or other plane pictorial representation of the  
8 lot, parcel or tract of land involved, shall be the  
9 personal property of the owner of the land involved."
