AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 13808.2 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT THE ORIGINAL TRACING OF A MAP BE THE PERSONAL PROPERTY OF AN OWNER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 13808.2 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 13808.2. Original tracing. Notwithstanding any provision of law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the original tracing of a map, plat, sketch or other plane pictorial representation of the lot, parcel or tract of land involved, shall be the personal property of the owner of the land involved."
