

Introduced by F. G. Lujan

AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 11300
OF CHAPTER IV, TITLE XII OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO TEACHER QUALIFI-
CATIONS ON GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11300 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

4 "Section 11300. Teachers: qualifications. Persons
5 employed in a teaching or supervisory capacity in the public
6 schools of Guam shall be permanent residents of the United
7 States of good moral character and shall hold a qualifying
8 certificate issued by the Director."

9 Section 2. Paragraph (1) of Subsection(f) of Section 4013
10 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as
11 follows:

12 "(1) As used in this subsection, 'officers' or
13 'employees' means all officers and employees of all three
14 branches of the government of Guam including boards, com-
15 missions, instrumentalities, and public corporations."
