AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 11300 OF CHAPTER IV, TITLE XII OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS ON GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11300 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

"Section 11300. Teachers: qualifications. Persons
employed in a teaching or supervisory capacity in the public
schools of Guam shall be permanent residents of the United
States of good moral character and shall hold a qualifying
certificate issued by the Director."

Section 2. Paragraph (1) of Subsection(f) of Section 4013 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) As used in this subsection, 'officers' or 'employees' means all officers and employees of all three branches of the government of Guam including boards, commissions, instrumentalities, and public corporations."
