



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTIONS (e) AND (f)  
(1) OF SECTION 13416 OF THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO ADJUSTING ACTION  
DATES IN THE GUAM TERRITORIAL SEASHORE  
PROTECTION ACT OF 1974.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (e) of Section 13416 of the  
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(e) Prepare its definitive conclusions and  
5 recommendations, including recommendations for areas  
6 that should be reserved for specific uses or within  
7 which specific uses should be prohibited, which it  
8 shall, after public hearing, adopt and submit to the  
9 Legislature no later than January, 1976."

10 Section 2. Subsection (f) (1) of Section 13416 of the  
11 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "(f) (1) On or after June 1, 1974 any person  
13 wishing to perform any development within the seashore  
14 reserve shall obtain a permit authorizing such develop-  
15 ment from the Commission, and, if required by law, from  
16 any other governmental department or agency. No permit  
17 shall be issued without the affirmative vote of a  
18 majority of the Board members."
