


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A FIVE-YEAR PLAN
FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF TAGACHAN BEACH
AS A SEASHORE RECREATIONAL SITE AND
ZOOLOGICAL PARK AND TO AUTHORIZE FUNDS
FOR SUCH PLAN.

1 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature:

2 THAT, Tagachan Beach, a natural coastal amphitheater
3 encompassing one hundred twelve acres, is dedicated as a
4 Territorial Park by Section 13004 of the Government Code of Guam;

5 THAT, the Territorial Recreation Master Plan of 1966
6 proposes that Tagachan Beach be developed as a seashore
7 recreational site including camping sites, trails, picnic
8 facilities, and swimming facilities; and

9 THAT, the Territorial Recreation Master Plan recommends the
10 establishment of a zoological park in the proposed Central Park,
11 but, because of the limited area and size of the central park, it
12 would be much more sensible to incorporate a zoological park into
13 the Tagachan Beach development plans; and

14 THAT, the development of a zoological park in such a
15 beautiful seashore setting would be a substantial addition to
16 Guam's inventory of recreational facilities and tourist
17 attractions; now therefore

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

19 Section 1. There is hereby created a five-year program to
20 develop Tagachan Beach into a seashore recreational area and
21 zoological park. The program shall include:

- 22 a. The preparation of engineering plans, specifications,
- 23 architectural designs, and cost workups for the recreational area
- 24 and zoo for which there is hereby authorized to be appropriated
- 25 the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) from the Unappropriated
- 26 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund. Said studies shall
- 27 be submitted to the Legislature for necessary implementation and
- 28 funding not later than twelve (12) months from the effective date
- 29 of this Act.

1 b. The acquisition and paving of an access road, the
2 construction of parking facilities and improvement of the beach
3 area, including picnic facilities and a beach maintenance
4 program, which shall be initiated immediately and for which
5 there is hereby authorized to be appropriated the sum of One
6 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the Unappropriated
7 Surplus of the General Fund.

8 Section 2. The administration of this program shall be
9 under the supervision of the Director of Commerce. The director
10 is encouraged to examine Hawaii's outstanding public beach
11 program and zoological park for their applicability to Guam, and
12 in particular for their applicability to the Tagachan Beach
13 development plan.
