




AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER II TO TITLE XI
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE
TO A QUALITY/RELIABILITY ASSURANCE
PROGRAM FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
WORKS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter II is hereby added to Title XI
3 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER II

5 Quality/Reliability Assurance Program

6 Section 10100. Program. A Quality/Reliability
7 Assurance Program designed to improve the quality,
8 reliability and durability of equipment and construction,
9 which is fabricated, repaired, installed, maintained,
10 supervised, administered or permitted; will be implemented
11 by the Department of Public Works, for government of Guam
12 projects, and construction authorized through Building
13 Permits.

14 Section 10101. Objectives. The Program shall be
15 geared to:

- 16 1) Inform employees of the importance of their work
17 contribution to the overall success of the
18 government of Guam and the Department of Public
19 Works in accomplishing their mission;
- 20 2) Identify and eliminate causes of error;
- 21 3) Motivate each employee to do the job right the
22 first time;
- 23 4) Develop the realization that personal job security
24 is related to the accomplishment of quality
25 workmanship;
- 26 5) Provide individual and/or group recognition for
27 superior workmanship;
- 28 6) Develop a spirit of team work, as well as
29 competition, among individuals or groups to

1 promote high quality work; and.

- 2 7) Compliment and support related efforts of safety,
3 beneficial suggestion, resource conservation, and
4 the zero defects philosophy.

5 Section 10102. Action and Responsibility. The
6 Director of Public Works shall be responsible for planning,
7 initiating, sustaining and evaluating this high priority
8 program, and for establishing merit awards to be given
9 to deserving employees who become involved."
