BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Five Thousand Dollars - (\$75,000), which sum is hereby appropriated, to provide for an ambulance to serve the village of Yona.

Section 2. There is hereby transferred to the General Fund from the Hospital Construction Fund the sum of TER OF Thousand Dollars (\$180,000), which sum is hereby appropriated, for the purpose of constructing a two-lane paved road in Yigo within the Takano, Salas and Bordallo Subdivisions.

Fund from the Hospital Construction Fund the sum of Seventy—

(\$20,000)

Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000), which sum is hereby appropriated, to provide for an ambulance to serve the village of Santa Rita.
