


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE OPERATIONS BUDGET FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1975; REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES TO KEEP CLOSE FISCAL CONTROLS OF ITS PUBLIC ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS; TO ADD SECTION 9112.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES TO DETERMINE THE NATIONALITY OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE APPLICANTS; AND TO TRANSFER FUNDS TO THE HOSPITAL CONSTRUCTION FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 2, III, C, 7 of Part One of Public Law 12-150 as amended by Public Law 12-181 and Public Law 12-198 is amended to read as follows:

"7. For Miscellaneous Items, not to exceed Three Million Eight Hundred Sixteen Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty Three Dollars (\$3,816,933). For educational leave, foster care and family planning services not to exceed	\$ 41,000
For cash assistance, not to exceed	\$2,375,933
For medical vendor payments, not to exceed	\$1,400,000"

Section 2. There is hereby transferred the sum of Six Hundred Eighteen Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Nine Dollars (\$618,469) from the Hospital Construction Fund to the General Fund to satisfy the local government matching fund requirements of the appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act.

Section 3. In administering Section 1 of this Act, the Department of Public Health & Social Services is directed to maintain the budgetary limitations established by Section 1 and in the event that the number of welfare cases administered

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1 by the department shall rise to more than 1600 cases,
2 the Director shall immediately advise the Bureau of Budget
3 & Management Research, which shall, in turn, immediately
4 submit a revised fiscal note to the Legislature concerning
5 the anticipated expenditure level of the programs being
6 administered by the social services division of the
7 department.

8 Section 4. A new Section 9112.1 is added to the
9 Government Code to read:

10 "Section 9112.1. The Director shall establish
11 administrative procedures to determine whether a person
12 applying for public assistance under this Chapter is
13 a United States citizen or an alien. In the case of
14 each alien the Director shall require proof of the
15 alien's lawful status in the United States. In the
16 event an alien refuses to submit such lawful proof, the
17 Director shall advise the Guam office of the Immigra-
18 tion and Naturalization Services, Department of Justice,
19 of the name of the alien and request that if the person
20 is an illegal alien or if the person has violated his
21 status by becoming a public charge that action be ini-
22 tiated to remove the person from the United States."

23 Section 5. Effective July 1, 1975, the sum of Six
24 Hundred Eighteen Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars
25 (\$618,469) is transferred from the Unappropriated Surplus
26 of the General Fund to the Hospital Construction Fund.
