AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11115 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE ESTABLISH-MENT OF ENRICIMENT AND COMPENSATORY PROGRAMS DURING JUNE, JULY AND AUGUST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. New Section 11115 is hereby added to Chapter II, Title XII, of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11115. Enrichment and Compensatory Programs. The Board shall adopt a policy providing for enrichment and compensatory education programs to be conducted throughout the island during June, July and August of each year. The policy may prescribe that, upon the recommendation of the appropriate school administrator, a pupil may be required to be enrolled in a class established as the result of the implementation of this section."

Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon resolution of the Board of Education at the end of school year 1974-75 and the Director of Education shall submit to the Legislature through the Governor a budget to provide for the initial implementation of this Act prior to June 15, 1975.
