AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM,
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE DEPART-
MENT OF EDUCATION TO MAKE COMMITMENTS FOR
THE RECRUITMENT OF INSTRUCTIONAL PERSONNEL
FROM OFF-ISLAND, FOR THE ORDERING OF IN-
STRUCTIONAL SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS AND
EQUIPMENT AND PURCHASE OF SCHOOL BUSES AND
PACKER TRUCKS AGAINST THEIR OPERATIONAL
APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING
JUNE 30, 1976.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The University of Guam, Department of Public
Works and the Department of Education are hereby authorized to
make commitments of the following amount as apportioned for the
purchase of school buses and packer trucks, recruitment of
instructional personnel from off-island and ordering of
instructional supplies and instructional equipment against
their operational appropriations for fiscal year ending
June 30, 1976.
