AN ACT AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF PUBLIC LAW 12-150 RELATIVE TO MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS AND REAPPROPRIATIONS TO SEVERAL AGENCIES/DEPARTMENTS TO ENABLE THEM TO PAY POWER BILLS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1975.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 9. No funds appropriated in this Act shall be used for any purpose except as otherwise expressly provided herein.

Section 10. The sums appropriated in this Act shall be subject to the Administrative Provisions of Part Twelve, Section Twenty-Two of Public Law 12-150.

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
