AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE FOR EFFECTIVE PARTICIPATION BY THE LEGIS-LATURE IN THE PACIFIC CONFERENCE OF LEGIS-LATORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Ceneral Fund, the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000). The sum herein appropriated shall constitute Guam's contribution to the Pacific Cenference of Legislators and said sum shall be transferred to the Treasurer of the Pacific Conference of Legislators to defray operational costs thereof as authorized by Section 1601 of the Gevernment Code of Guam.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, rules, or regulations, to the contrary, the Director of the Department of Administration shall be the certifying officer of Guam's contribution to the Pacific Conference of Legislators.

Section 3. Transferring of any monies in the implementation of Section 1 of this Act shall be on the condition that the Treasurer of the Pacific Conference of Legislators shall publish in a newspaper of general circulation in Guam at least once the financial statements balance sheet, the income and expense statements, within ninety (90) days after the conference.
