AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 10 AND 11 OF
PUBLIC LAW 12-198; TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS
FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FIFTH SOUTH
PACIFIC GAMES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

1
2 Section 1. The first paragraph of Section 10 of Public Law
3 12-198 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 10. Notwithstanding any provision of law,
5 rules, or regulations to the contrary, the sum of Ninety-
6 Six Thousand Ninety-Seven Dollars (\$96,097) is hereby
7 appropriated from any available fund in the Unappropriated
8 Surplus of the Tourist Attraction Fund for the operation of
9 the Fifth South Pacific Games Commission for the period
10 commencing January 1, 1973, and ending September 30, 1975,
11 said sums to be transferred to the Guam South Pacific Games
12 Commission and to be allocated as follows:"

13 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappro-
14 priated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Forty-
15 Eight Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$148,289) to
16 supplement the appropriation made under Section 10 of Public Law
17 12-198, said sum to be allocated as follows:

1 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappro-
2 priated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Four
3 Thousand Six Hundred and Ninety-One Dollars (\$24,691) to finance
4 the participation of Guam's Athletes in the Fifth South Pacific
5 Games, said sum to be allocated as follows:

24 Section 4. Section 11 of Public Law 12-198 is hereby
25 amended to read as follows:

26 "Section 11. Schedule One of positions for the Fifth
27 South Pacific Games Commission.

28 One (1) Administrator at Pay range 35.

29 One (1) Public Relations Officer at pay range 33.

30 One (1) Executive Secretary at pay range 19.

1 One (1) Photographer at pay range 18.

2 Three (3) Clerks at pay range 10, each.

3 One (1) General Helper at pay range 4."

4 Section 5. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to
5 the contrary, the Governor of Guam is authorized to direct the
6 various Departments, Agencies, Commissions and other political
7 subdivisions of the Government of Guam to provide in-kind
8 support, without reimbursement therefor to the Fifth South Paci-
9 fic Games Commission for the successful operation of the Fifth
10 South Pacific Games. On or before the 15th day of each month
11 following the enactment of this measure into law, the Governor
12 shall cause to be filed with the Thirteenth Guam Legislature a
13 report containing inter alia all in-kind support from whatever
14 source derived and an estimate of the value of such support.

15 Section 6. The Governor shall cause to be filed on the 15th
16 day of each month after the effective date of this Act a detail-
17 ed report with the Thirteenth Guam Legislature setting forth
18 inter alia any expenditures, commitments or other obligations
19 entered into. Any funds not obligated, committed or expended
20 under Public Law 12-198 and this Act as of September 30, 1975,
21 shall automatically revert to the Tourist Attraction Fund and
22 the General Fund respectively.

23 Section 7. All materials, supplies, and equipment or any
24 item of value purchased with funds appropriated by Public Law
25 12-198 or by this Act shall become the property of the Govern-
26 ment of Guam upon the termination of the Fifth South Pacific
27 Games and the Department of Parks and Recreation shall have the
28 right of first refusal to such property. In addition, all net
29 revenues derived from the operation of the Fifth South Pacific

1 Games shall be applied as an offset against funds appropriated
2 by this Act and such net revenues shall be placed in the General
3 Fund of the Government of Guam or the Tourist Attraction Fund
4 in accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of this Act.

5 Section 8. Notwithstanding any law, rule, regulation, or
6 agreement to the contrary, one-third (1/3) of all net revenues
7 realized from any operations of the Fifth South Pacific Games,
8 shall be deposited in the Tourist Attraction Fund and two
9 thirds (2/3) of such revenues shall be deposited in the General
10 Fund.

11 Section 9. Any funds appropriated by this Act which are
12 not obligated, committed, or otherwise expended or any net
13 revenues realized under Section 8 which are in excess of the
14 appropriations from the Tourist Attraction Fund, pursuant to
15 Section 10 of Public Law 12-198, or the General Fund, pursuant
16 to this Act, shall be retained by the South Pacific Games
17 Council.

18 Section 10. All expenditures made pursuant to this Act
19 and Sections 10 and 11 of Public Law 12-198 after the effective
20 date of this Act shall be certified by the Director of the
21 Department of Administration, or his designee in writing.

22 Section 11. The Legislature hereby reserves the power to
23 grant to the South Pacific Games Commission by a resolution
24 adopted by the Legislature, the power and authority to transfer
25 funds appropriated by this Act, provided, however, that the
26 funds so transferred are to be used for a purpose enumerated
27 in this Act.

28 Section 12. Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become
29 effective on July 1, 1975. The Legislature hereby grants

1 authority to the South Pacific Games Commission to commit or
2 obligate funds appropriated by Sections 2 and 3 of this Act
3 prior to July 1, 1975.

4 Section 13. There is hereby appropriated from any available
5 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of
6 Twenty-One Thousand Dollars (\$21,000) to the Association of
7 Retired Persons for the Servicio Para Y Man Amko (services of
8 the Senior Citizens). This Section of the Act shall be
9 effective upon signature of the Governor.

10 Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from any
11 available surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Thousand
12 Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) to the Public Utility Agency
13 of Guam for the purchase of a water pump to provide adequate
14 water pressure to agricultural areas in the San Isidro area,
15 municipality of Agat. This Section shall be effective upon enact-
16 ment of this Act.

17 Section 15. There is hereby reappropriated the sum of Two
18 ^{ZERO} ~~Hundred-Fifty-Thousand-Dollars-(\$250,000.00)~~ ^{- 0 -} from the lapses of
19 the Department of Education for the implementation of Public Law
20 13-7 Compensatory Elementary Education Summer Program and Career
21 Awareness Time (CAT).

22 Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any availa-
23 ble funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
24 ^{ZERO} ~~sum of Three Hundred-Twenty-Five-Thousand-Dollars-(\$325,000.00)~~ ^{- 0 -}
25 to the Department of Labor for the purpose of providing summer
26 employment for students of the various schools in Guam who are
27 at least sixteen (16) years of age, such students to be employed
28 during the summer period between school terms either by the
29 Government of Guam or by private employers approved by the

1 Department of Labor.

2 a. All students employed under the Public Sector provi-
3 sions of Section 16, except the Department of
4 Agriculture, shall be given job assignments and tasks
5 as assistants to the department or agency head or
6 deputy, division chief or administrator, or section
7 supervisor, or in any other capacity where they may
8 participate in meaningful work experience. In no way
9 is a participant to be assigned as a messenger,
10 custodian, or general helper.

11 b. All students and their adult counterparts are required
12 to submit a summary of their experiences at the end of
13 the program to the Guam Employment Service.

14 Section 17. Section 2. II. C. 1 and 2 of Public Law 12-150
15 is hereby amended to read:

16 "C. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

17 1. For Personal Services, not to exceed the
18 total of Nine Hundred Thirteen Thousand
19 Five Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$913,524)
20 increased to defray costs for reclassifica-
21 tion of positions for the positions
22 enumerated in Schedule Twenty of Section 3
23 of Public Law 12-150.

24 2. For Personnel Benefits, not to exceed the
25 total of Ninety-Two Thousand Seventy-Three
26 Dollars (\$92,073) as follows:

27 Section 18. There is hereby appropriated from any
28 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
29 Fund, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the

1 purchase of seeds and plant nursery supplies for the Department
2 of Agriculture.

3 Section 19. There is hereby appropriated from any
4 available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
5 Fund the sum of ^{ZERO} ~~Eighty-Thousand-Dollars-(\$80,000.00)~~ ^{- 0 -}, for the
6 replacement of livestock at the Department of Agriculture,
7 such sum to include transportation costs.

8 Section 20. Section 19 of this Act shall take effect July
9 1, 1975.

10 Section 21. There is hereby appropriated from any
11 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
12 Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the extension
13 of Tamuning Commissioner's Office for use as a Community Center.

14 Section 22. There is hereby transferred to the budget of
15 the Committee on Education of the Thirteenth Guam Legislature
16 from the appropriation to the University of Guam provided for
17 by Public Law 12-150 the sum of ^{ZERO} ~~One-Hundred-Thousand-Dollars~~
18 ^{- 0 -} (\$100,000) to be used by the Committee on Education of the
19 Guam Legislature for an indepth survey of the administrative
20 management, financial management and academic standing of the
21 University of Guam and the Department of Education. Funds
22 transferred herein shall be those funds not expended by the
23 University because of personnel lapses.
