AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 10 AND 11 OF PUBLIC LAW 12-198; TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FIFTH SOUTH PACIFIC GAMES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. The first paragraph of Section 10 of Public Law 12-198 is hereby amended to read as follows:

\*Section 10. Notwithstanding any provision of law, rules, or regulations to the contrary, the sum of Ninety-Six Thousand Ninety-Seven Dollars (\$96,097) is hereby appropriated from any available fund in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Tourist Attraction Fund for the operation of the Fifth South Pacific Games Commission for the period commencing January 1, 1973, and ending September 30, 1975, said sums to be transferred to the Guam South Pacific Games Commission and to be allocated as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$148,289) to supplement the appropriation made under Section 10 of Public Law 12-198, said sum to be allocated as follows:

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Four Thousand Six Hundred and Ninety-One Dollars (\$24,691) to finance the participation of Guam's Athletes in the Fifth South Pacific Games, said sum to be allocated as follows:

Section 4. Section 11 of Public Law 12-198 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 11. Schedule One of positions for the Fifth South Pacific Games Commission.

One (1) Administrator at Pay range 35.

Section 5. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, the Governor of Guam is authorized to direct the various Departments, Agencies, Commissions and other political subdivisions of the Government of Guam to provide in-kind support, without reimbursement therefor to the Fifth South Pacific Games Commission for the successful operation of the Fifth South Pacific Games. On or before the 15th day of each month following the enactment of this measure into law, the Governor shall cause to be filed with the Thirteenth Guam Legislature a report containing inter alia all in-kind support from whatever source derived and an estimate of the value of such support.

Section 6. The Governor shall cause to be filed on the 15th day of each month after the effective date of this Act a detailed report with the Thirteenth Guam Legislature setting forth inter alia any expenditures, commitments or other obligations entered into. Any funds not obligated, committed or expended under Public Law 12-198 and this Act as of September 30, 1975, shall automatically revert to the Tourist Attraction Fund and the General Fund respectively.

Section 7. All materials, supplies, and equipment or any item of value purchased with funds appropriated by Public Law 12-198 or by this Act shall become the property of the Government of Guam upon the termination of the Fifth South Pacific Games and the Department of Parks and Accreation shall have the right of first refusal to such property. In addition, all not revenues derived from the operation of the Fifth South Pacific

Games shall be applied as an offset against funds appropriated by this Act and such net revenues shall be placed in the General Fund of the Government of Guam or the Tourist Attraction Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of this Act.

Section 8. Notwithstanding any law, rule, regulation, or agreement to the contrary, one-third (1/3) of all net revenues realized from any operations of the Fifth South Pacific Games, shall be deposited in the Tourist Attraction Fund and two thirds (2/3) of such revenues shall be deposited in the General Fund.

Section 9. Any funds appropriated by this Act which are not obligated, committed, or otherwise expended or any net revenues realized under Section 8 which are in excess of the appropriations from the Tourist Attraction Fund, pursuant to Section 10 of Public Law 12-198, or the General Fund, pursuant to this Act, shall be retained by the South Pacific Games Council.

Section 10. All expenditures made pursuant to this Act and Sections 10 and 11 of Public Law 12-198 after the effective date of this Act shall be certified by the Director of the Department of Administration, or his designee in writing.

Section 11. The Legislature hereby reserves the power to grant to the South Pacific Games Commission by a resolution adopted by the Legislature, the power and authority to transfer funds appropriated by this Act, provided, however, that the funds so transferred are to be used for a purpose enumerated in this Act.

Section 12. Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 1975. The Logislature hereby grants

authority to the South Pacific Games Commission to commit or obligate funds appropriated by Sections 2 and 3 of this Act prior to July 1, 1975.

Section 13. There is hereby appropriated from any svailable funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-One Thousand Dollars (\$21,000) to the Association of Retired Persons for the Servicio Para Y Man Amko (services of the Senior Citizens). This Section of the Act shall be effective upon signature of the Governor.

Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from any available surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the purchase of a water pump to provide adequate water pressure to agricultural areas in the San Isidro area, municipality of Agat. This Section shall be effective upon enactment of this Act.

Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the ZERO sum of Three Hundred-Twenty-Five-Thousand-Dollars-(\$325,000.00) to the Department of Labor for the purpose of providing summer employment for students of the various schools in Guam who are at least sixteen (16) years of age, such students to be employed during the summer period between school terms either by the Government of Guam or by private employers approved by the

Department of Labor.

- sions of Section 16, except the Department of
  Agriculture, shall be given job assignments and tasks
  as assistants to the department or agency head or
  deputy, division chief or administrator, or section
  supervisor, or in any other capacity where they may
  participate in meaningful work experience. In no way
  is a participant to be assigned as a messenger,
  custodian, or general helper.
- b. All students and their adult counterparts are required to submit a summary of their experiences at the end of the program to the Guam Employment Service.

Section 17. Section 2. II. C. 1 and 2 of Public Law 12-150 is hereby amended to read:

## "C. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

Section 18. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the

purchase of seeds and plant nursery supplies for the Department of Agriculture.

Section 19. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General ZERO -0Fund the sum of Fighty-Thousand-Dellars-(\$80,000:00), for the replacement of livestock at the Department of Agriculture, such sum to include transportation costs.

Section 20. Section 19 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1975.

Section 21. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the extension of Tamuning Commissioner's Office for use as a Community Center.

Section 22. There is hereby transferred to the budget of the Committee on Education of the Thirteenth Guam Legislature from the appropriation to the University of Guam provided for ZERO by Public Law 12-150 the sum of One-Hundred-Thousand-Bollars (\$100,000) to be used by the Committee on Education of the Guam Legislature for an indepth survey of the administrative management, financial management and academic standing of the University of Guam and the Department of Education. Funds transferred herein shall be those funds not expended by the University because of personnel lapses.
