AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2910 OF THE GOVERN-MENT CODE TO PROVIDE THAT THE PRIMARY SHALL BE HELD ON THE FIRST SATURDAY OF SEPTEMBER IN EVERY EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 2910 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read:

"Section 2910. Primary date. The primary shall be held at the regular polling place or places in each precinct on the first Saturday of September in every even-numbered year."
