

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2910 OF THE GOVERN-
MENT CODE TO PROVIDE THAT THE PRIMARY SHALL
BE HELD ON THE FIRST SATURDAY OF SEPTEMBER
IN EVERY EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 2910 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is amended to read:

4 "Section 2910. Primary date. The primary shall be
5 held at the regular polling place or places in each pre-
6 cinct on the first Saturday of September in every even-
7 numbered year."
