AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR  
SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM, AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BB IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any  
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
4 General Fund the sum of <sup>ZERO</sup> ~~Three Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand~~  
5 ~~Dollars (\$325,000.00)~~ <sup>(0)</sup> to the Department of Labor for the  
6 purpose of providing summer employment for students of the  
7 various schools in Guam who are at least (16) years of age,  
8 such students to be employed during the summer period between  
9 school terms either by the Government of Guam or by private  
10 employers approved by the Department of Labor.

11 (a) All students employed by the Government of Guam,  
12 except the Department of Agriculture, and except those to be  
13 hired by private businesses, shall be given job assignments  
14 and tasks as assistants to the department or agency head or  
15 deputy, division chief or administrator, or section supervisor,  
16 or in any other capacity where they may participate in meaning-  
17 ful work experience.

18 (b) All students and their adult counterparts are re-  
19 quired to submit a summary of their work experiences at the  
20 end of the program to the Guam Employment Service.

1           Section 2. The appropriation made in Section 1, or  
2 any part or portion thereof, may be utilized to match Federal  
3 grants to fund Summer Youth Employment Programs.

4           Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any  
5 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
6 Fund the sum of Ninety Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Nine  
7 Dollars (\$90,639), (\$75,000 is the federal share and \$15,639  
8 is the local share) to the Department of Agriculture to  
9 carry out the Youth Conservation Program.

10          Section 4. Not inconsistent with law, the hourly wage  
11 rate under the program funded by Section 1 shall be so set as  
12 the maximize the employment of students.
