AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION PROJECT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated Eighty-Five
Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Eight Bollars (\$85,568) for Historic Preservation Projects of which Forty Thousand Five
Hundred Dollars (\$40,500) shall be appropriated from any
available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Tourist
Attraction Fund matched on a fifty percent (50%) basis granted
by the National Park Service at the amount of Forty-Five
Thousand Sixty Eight Dollars (\$45,068) and shall be allocated
as follows:

А.	For repairs to the Plaza de Espana,	
	Agana	\$ 9,368
B.	For the excavation, stabilization, and	
	research of Fort San Jose, Umatac	60,000
C.	For research towards the restoration	
	of the Palace within the Plaza de	
	Espana, Agana	16,200

Section 2. Payment of funds from this appropriation shall only be by a payment voucher signed by the State Historic Preservation Officer of Guam.
