AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE
TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND FOR HISTORIC
PRESERVATION PROJECT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated Eighty-Five
3 Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$85,568) for His-
4 toric Preservation Projects of which Forty Thousand Five
5 Hundred Dollars (\$40,500) shall be appropriated from any
6 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Tourist
7 Attraction Fund matched on a fifty percent (50%) basis granted
8 by the National Park Service at the amount of Forty-Five
9 Thousand Sixty Eight Dollars (\$45,068) and shall be allocated
10 as follows:
