Introduced by J. H. Underwood

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37003(j) OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE
FOR WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FOR RESERVE
POLICEMEN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 37003(j) of Chapter 1, Title XXXIII,
3 of the Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "(j). Any person who may be injured in performing
6 service for the Government of Guam as a volunteer fireman
7 or reserve policeman under the authorized direction of a
8 public officer or employee, and who shall not have secured
9 compensation from the Government of Guam or from any third
10 person, shall be paid compensation equivalent to that of a
11 firefighter or policeman. The Commission shall adopt rules
12 and regulations regarding implementation of this Section."
