AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 11844 TO
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO ESTABLISH
A UNIVERSITY CAMPUS SECURITY FORCE AT
THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND TO PRESCRIBE
DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE SAME.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new section, Section 11844, is hereby
3 added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 11844. Campus Security. There is hereby
5 established, at the University of Guam, a University
6 Campus Security Force which shall be responsible for
7 the protection of persons and property at the University
8 of Guam and which shall coordinate its activities with
9 the Department of Public Safety. The Board of Regents,
10 pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act, shall
11 adopt rules and regulations regarding security at the
12 University of Guam and rules and regulations regarding
13 personnel, which shall be in accordance with the
14 provisions of Title V of the Government Code of Guam.
15 Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the
16 contrary, members of the University Campus Security
17 Force, while on Campus and acting within their official
18 capacity, shall have the powers of peace officers,
19 including, but not limited to, the power to arrest, the
20 power to enforce University Security Regulations, the
21 Vehicle Code of Guam, and the Penal Code of Guam."

22 Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Act
23 shall become operative on the ninetieth day following
24 its enactment into law.
