Introduced by J. M. Rivera

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3005 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO REDUCE FROM 40 TO 35 THE LENGTH
OF TIME REQUIRED FOR THE AWARDING OF A GOLD SERVICE
MEDAL FOR SERVICE TO THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 3005 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read:

4 "Section 3005. Same: gold. An award for faithful
5 service to the Government of Guam is established and
6 shall be known as the Gold Service Medal.

7 This medal shall be granted by the government of
8 Guam to any person who has faithfully served the govern-
9 ment of Guam not less than 35 years. Creditable service
10 to the Naval Government of Guam in a civil capacity,
11 or active service in the Guam Militia, shall be counted
12 toward the time necessary to establish eligibility for
13 this medal. Service in a federal capacity shall also
14 be counted, provided such service has been directly in
15 connection with government of Guam activities.

16 The Gold Service Medal may be worn by its recipient
17 on occasions of ceremony."
