AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 11845, 11846 AND 11847
TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM ACCEPTING THE
PROVISIONS OF THE VARIOUS FEDERAL LAND GRANT
ACTS AND CREATING THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM LAND
GRANT RESEARCH AND EXTENSION SPECIAL FUND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Sections 11845, 11846 and 11847 are hereby added
3 to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 11845. Assent to Provisions of Hatch and
5 McIntire-Stennis Acts; Administration by University of Guam.
6 The provisions of the Hatch Act, and the McIntire-Stennis
7 Act, the Federal formula funds, and the purposes of such funds
8 authorized by said Acts and the laws and regulations supple-
9 mentary thereto providing for an Agricultural Experiment
10 Station in connection with a College of Agriculture and
11 Mechanic Arts and by other Acts of Congress for similar
12 purposes are hereby assented to and accepted by the
13 Legislature of Guam on behalf of the University of Guam.
14 The Legislature further directs that the University
15 of Guam shall administer and direct the Guam Agricultural
16 Experiment Station which shall be established in consonance
17 with said Act.

1 Section 11846. Assent to Smith-Lover Act relative to
2 Extension Services; Administration by University of Guam. The
3 Legislature of Guam hereby assents to, and accepts the pro-
4 visions and requirements of the Smith-Lever Act and the laws
5 and regulations supplementary thereto. The Legislature
6 further directs that the University of Guam shall administer
7 the formula funds made under such Act and shall organize,
8 conduct and administer the Cooperative Extension Service in
9 accordance with the terms and conditions of said Act.

10 Section 11847. University of Guam Land Grant Research
11 and Extension Special Fund.

12 (a) For the purpose of compliance with Federal Laws
13 designating the University of Guam as one of the Land Grant
14 Colleges eligible to receive land grant Federal funds for the
15 benefit of research and extension services, there is hereby
16 established the 'University of Guam Land Grant Research and
17 Extension Special Fund' (the 'Research and Extension Fund'),
18 which shall be maintained separate and apart from any other
19 funds of the government of Guam and independent records and
20 accounts thereof shall be maintained by the University of
21 Guam. A quarterly financial statement of the Research and
22 Extension Fund shall be submitted to the Legislature, the
23 Department of Administration, and the Bureau of Budget and
24 Management Research.

25 (b) All Federal grants, Federal formula funds, dona-
26 tions, and charitable contributions relating to agricultural
27 and forestry research and extension services shall be
28 deposited and credited to the Research and Extension Fund.

1 The Legislature may appropriate or reappropriate to the
2 Research and Extension Fund any local matching funds necessary
3 for approved University of Guam Programs consistent with
4 Research and Extension Programs in the areas of Agriculture,
5 Home Economics, Forestry and any related programs.

6 (c) All income derived from the operation and services
7 of the research farm and cooperative extension services by
8 the University of Guam shall be deposited in and credited to
9 the Research and Extension Fund.

10 (d) All debts, liabilities and any other obligations
11 incurred for programs described in Subsection (b) of this
12 Section shall be paid from the Research and Extension Fund."
