AN ACT TO INCLUDE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PUBLIC MARINA IN A FIVE-YEAR SMALL BOAT LAUNCHING RAMPS AND MARINA PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law 12-127 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Five-year small boat launching ramps program; administration. There is hereby created a program to provide small boat launching ramps and marina over a period of five (5) years commencing July 1, 1975. The program shall include preparation of engineering plans and specifications, the paving of access roads, the construction of parking facilities, the construction of ramps, and if necessary, the acquisition of access roads and parking facilities, and the dredging of channels for launching. The administration of this program shall be under the supervision of the Director of Commerce, or the Director of Parks and Recreation should Public Law 12-209 be implemented."

Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law 12-127 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated, from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Four Million Eight Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$4,840,000). This authorization shall be reduced by the sum of any Federal grants-in-aid provided for the purposes of this

1 program and shall be apportioned among the following 2 municipal districts of Guam in the following amounts: 3 Municipalities Amounts Tumon (San Vitores) 4 \$ 60,000 Piti 5 60,000 Agat (Talifac River Area) б 2,500,000 Umatac 7 40,000 8 Merizo (public pier) 2,000,000 9 Inarajan 60,000 10 Talofofo 60,000 11 Yona (Ylig) 60,000 12 Pago Bay 60,000" 13 Section 3. A new Section 4 to Public Law 12-127 is 14 hereby added to read as follows:

Section 4. Criteria. The launching ramps and marinas shall be located, designed, constructed and managed in a manner which will best serve the following criteria:

> (a) That the interests and needs of the people of their municipality where each such facility is located are of primary concern and that its residents should serve an active role in planning the facility;

That this facility be an integral and complimen-**(b)** tary part of the municipality's development plan; and

That the environmental, historical and cultural (c) integrity of the municipality or village, and its offshore waters be preserved and protected."
