AN ACT TO INCLUDE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A  
PUBLIC MARINA IN A FIVE-YEAR SMALL BOAT  
LAUNCHING RAMPS AND MARINA PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law 12-127 is hereby  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Five-year small boat launching ramps  
5 program; administration. There is hereby created a program  
6 to provide small boat launching ramps and marina over a period  
7 of five (5) years commencing July 1, 1975. The program shall  
8 include preparation of engineering plans and specifications,  
9 the paving of access roads, the construction of parking  
10 facilities, the construction of ramps, and if necessary,  
11 the acquisition of access roads and parking facilities, and  
12 the dredging of channels for launching. The administration  
13 of this program shall be under the supervision of the Director  
14 of Commerce, or the Director of Parks and Recreation should  
15 Public Law 12-209 be implemented."

16 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law 12-127 is hereby  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 "Section 3. There is hereby authorized to be appropri-  
19 ated, from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
20 sum of Four Million Eight Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars  
21 (\$4,840,000). This authorization shall be reduced by the sum  
22 of any Federal grants-in-aid provided for the purposes of this

1 program and shall be apportioned among the following  
2 municipal districts of Guam in the following amounts:

3	Municipalities	Amounts
4	Tumon (San Vitores)	\$ 60,000
5	Piti	60,000
6	Agat (Talifac River Area)	2,500,000
7	Umatac	40,000
8	Merizo (public pier)	2,000,000
9	Inarajan	60,000
10	Talofofo	60,000
11	Yona (Ylig)	60,000
12	Pago Bay	60,000"

13 Section 3. A new Section 4 to Public Law 12-127 is  
14 hereby added to read as follows:

15 Section 4. Criteria. The launching ramps and marinas  
16 shall be located, designed, constructed and managed in a  
17 manner which will best serve the following criteria:

18 (a) That the interests and needs of the people of  
19 their municipality where each such facility is located  
20 are of primary concern and that its residents should serve  
21 an active role in planning the facility;

22 (b) That this facility be an integral and complimen-  
23 tary part of the municipality's development plan; and

24 (c) That the environmental, historical and cultural  
25 integrity of the municipality or village, and its off-  
26 shore waters be preserved and protected."
