




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
INTERSCHOLASTICS PROGRAM OF THE DEPART-  
MENT OF EDUCATION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new subsection VII.B.a, which shall  
3 follow subsection VII.A.c., is added to Section 2, Part One,  
4 of Public Law 13-37:

5 VII. RECREATION

6 B. Department of Education

7 a. Interscholastics Program for  
8 Secondary Schools.

- 9 1. For personal services,  
10 not to exceed \$48,011  
11 2. For personnel  
12 benefits, not to  
13 exceed \$ 1,607  
14 3. For travel and  
15 transportation,  
16 not to exceed the  
17 total of Five  
18 Hundred Dollars  
19 (\$500.00) as follows:

1 For local travel  
2 mileage reimbursement,  
3 not to exceed \$ 500

4 4. For contractual  
5 services, not to  
6 exceed \$38,500

7 5. For supplies and  
8 materials, not to  
9 exceed \$14,030.

10 Section 2. Section 39(L) of Part Six, Public Law  
11 13-37 is repealed in its entirety.

12 Section 3. Subsection IV.C.f.3. of Section 2, Part  
13 One of Public Law 13-37 is amended to read:

14 IV. EDUCATION

15 "C.f.3. For travel and transportation not  
16 to exceed the total of Two Hundred  
17 Ninety-Four Thousand Three Hundred  
18 Twenty-Eight Dollars (\$294,328) as  
19 follows:

20 For off-island travel for terminations,  
21 or recruitment, not to exceed \$291,000

22 For local travel, mileage reim-  
23 bursement not to exceed \$ 3,328."

24 Section 4. Section 35 of Part Six, Public Law 13-37,  
25 is amended to read:

26 "Section 35. Notwithstanding any law or rules and  
27 regulations to the contrary, any authorized position

1 funded by this Act which is vacant on the date of  
2 passage of this Act shall remain vacant, unless such  
3 position contributes directly to the health or safety of  
4 Guam residents and is deemed immediately necessary to  
5 such program areas. Additionally, any vacant position  
6 which is entirely federally funded during this and  
7 future fiscal year, and any position which will be  
8 revenue producing and will directly cause more revenues  
9 to be realized by the government of Guam may also be  
10 filled. This section shall not apply to the filling of  
11 vacancies in classroom teaching positions, professorial  
12 positions, and cafeteria workers positions, provided that  
13 the term cafeteria worker position shall not include  
14 cafeteria managers or administrative and clerical  
15 personnel."

16 Section 5. Section 39(d) of Part Six of Public Law  
17 13-37 is amended to read:

18 "(d). Each teacher shall spend not less than 300  
19 minutes of each school day instructing pupils. This may  
20 be accomplished by establishing five (5) 60-minute  
21 periods or six (6) 50-minute periods for each for each  
22 teacher. Pupils are to be provided 300 minutes of  
23 instruction each school day provided, however, that this  
24 provision shall not apply to kindergarten pupils, whose  
25 instructional time shall be as established by the  
26 Department of Education."

27 Section 6. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated

1 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
2 General Fund, the sum of One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars  
3 (\$180,000) for the operation of the Therapeutic Community  
4 Center as established by Public Law 12-81.

5 Section 7. Section 4 of Part Six of Public Law 13-37  
6 is amended to read:

7 "Section 4. None of the appropriations made pursuant  
8 to Section 2 through 7, Part One of this Act (appropriations  
9 from the General Fund) shall be used to pay for obligations  
10 committed, or expenditures made, prior to July 1, 1975,  
11 consistent with Section 20, Part Six of this Act with the  
12 exception that appropriations for the payment of telephone  
13 expenses in Section 5, Part One, of this Act may be used  
14 for the payment of telephone expenses incurred during  
15 FY '75; said expenditures for said telephone expenses shall  
16 be subject to the approval of the Director of the Bureau  
17 of Budget and Management Research."
